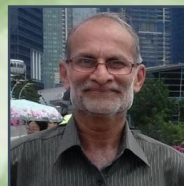

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER AND ORAL PRESENTATION

- Scientific abstracts are invited for poster and oral presentation. Abstract of interdisciplinary original and unpublished research or review preferably involving Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Quality Assurance or Phytochemistry shall reach the scientific committee by 20th February 2019.
- The abstract should be submitted online via E-mail in MS word (Formatting requirements: Times New Roman, font size-12, 1.5 cm spacing with maximum 250 words) to tm.gmmpc@gmail.com.
- Only registered candidates will be allowed to present the accepted papers and he/she must be one of the co-authors of the publication during submission.
- The number of authors should not exceed three.
- The abstract should include title in capital, author's surname followed by initials and affiliation.
- The name of the presenting author should be indicated by underlining the author's name.
- The size of the poster should not exceed 100 cm X 100 cm.
- Not more than one abstract should be submitted by one author.
- Three amongst the submitted abstracts will be selected for oral presentation and authors will be informed on or before 23/02/2019.
- A time slot of 15 minutes will be allotted to the presenter for presenting his/her work.
