Pharmacy courses hereby informed that Scholarship form for (Minority communities Muslim, Buddhist, Christian, Sikh, Parsi, Jain & Jews) is available on <https://mahadbtmahait.gov.in/Home/Index> Kindly submit the duly filled form along with following documents on or before 05th January, 2021.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicant should have Nationality of India.
2. Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
3. Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
4. The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than 8 Lakhs.
5. Minimum 80 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for freshly admitted in College).
6. During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

➤ **Document Required:**


1. Educational Certificate – S.S.C (10th) & onwards.
2. Income and Minority declaration – Affidavit on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper or Income certificate from the employer, if any.

3. School leaving certificate can also be considered as Proof of Minority or Self Declaration.
4. Self-Attested copy of Leaving Certificate
5. Self Attested copy of Ration Card
6. Self Attested copy of Fees Receipt
7. Certified true copy of Domicile certificate
8. Certified true copy of Gap Certificate (If Applicable)
9. Aadhaar card linked bank account pass book details
10. Self-Attested copy of Aadhar Card.
11. Filled Bank Aadhaar linking form

➤ **Note :**

1. Students should note that no application will be considered for Minority Scholarship under any circumstances after the last date i.e. 05th January, 2021.
2. The scholarship shall be transferred in candidate's account through Aadhaar Based, hence the candidate should fill the details carefully and recheck before finalizing the application form. (submission of wrong details leads to rejection of scholarship)
