
in the first day, students learned about interview etiquettes. Fun activities were performed by forming teams for the better comprehension of the significance of interaction and healthy communication amongst team members.

PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH IN EDUCATION



Seminar Report

Topic: Pedagogical Approach In Education

The Placement Cell of Oriental College of Pharmacy, Navi Mumbai had organized a seminar on, 'Pedagogical Approach in Education' on 7th December, 2022 from 11.00 A.M to 2.00 P.M. The session was held for the Faculty at Ocp in Final Year classroom (403) and Dr. Vithoba Sawant, Prof. Pooja Tiwari and Prof. Kinkini Dutta were invited as guest speakers.

The technical team of the placement Cell came up with an official flier and invite. Faculty at ocp had actively participated in the seminar.

At 11.00 am sharp, Ms. Pooja Gawade and Ms. Khushi Gupta, the hosts for the session welcomed Principal Dr. Mrs. Sudha Rathod ma'am, Our Vice principal and event coordinator Dr. Mohib Khan sir, the Placement Cell Incharge, Dr. Mrs. Vandana Jain ma'am, and the speakers for the session, Dr. Vithoba Sawant, Prof. Pooja Tiwari and Prof. Kinkini Dutta and the faculty members.

"Pedagogy is not about training, it is about critically educating people to be self reflective, capable of critically addressing their relationship with others and with the larger world. Pedagogy in this sense provides not only important critical and intellectual competencies; it also enables people to intervene critically in the world." ~ Henry Giroux .Pedagogy, most commonly understood as the approach to teaching, is the theory and practice of learning, and how this process influences, and is influenced by, the social, political and psychological development of learners. First Dr. Vithoba Sawant briefed about explanation skill creative learning in which he talked about how Cooperative learning is an activity which helps students to work in groups and how it enables them to learn and teach group members. Also, the success of each member depends on the group's success. He then proceeded to further explain his topic with the help of a puppet show. He divided the teachers into groups of four and asked them to answer a few questions, with one of the group members to present the answer. Further he briefed about the importance of 2 way communication. Next, Prof. Pooja Tiwari provided us with some enlightening information about the role of stimulus variation skill technology in learning. She discussed how Google Classroom and other online platforms can be used to teach while keeping students' attention spans intact. She also talked about how the teacher should be aware of the students' conditions in class, as it is critical to make teaching and learning effective. The procedure is entertaining. The teacher should use stimulus variation that is appropriate for the students to get their attention. The teacher should be aware that providing the same stimulus at every meeting bores students. As a result, the teacher should incorporate some variety into the teaching and learning process. She goes on to explain that there are five components of the stimulus variation used by teachers, namely teacher movement, attentional behavior, changes in speech patterns, changes in interactions, and changes in sensory channels. Researchers directly observe classroom interactions to learn more about the components used by teachers in schools. Based on the results, it can be concluded that all components of the stimulus variation are used in the teaching and learning process. Prof. Kinkini Dutta largely focused on Education innovation which is not a specific term





Glimpses of Day 1



Their functions & role in the production of high quality tablets was explained to all.



COMPUTER AIDED DRUG DESIGN: AN OVERVIEW





About the Webinar:

Drug discovery is a very time consuming and fund draining process. Traditional drug discovery process involves a lot of synthetic and biological work. Computer Aided Drug Design (CADD) helps scientists in minimizing the synthetic and biological testing efforts by focusing only on the most promising compounds. Besides explaining the molecular basis of therapeutic activity, it also predicts possible derivatives that would improve the activity. Thus, Drug discovery and development process is being streamlined using computing power. Traditional experimentation which requires animal and human models can be replaced by CADD, saving both time and cost. CADD also leads to the construction of high-quality datasets and libraries that can be optimized for high molecular diversity or similarity. The main aim of this webinar is to make all attendees acquainted about the basic strategies used in Computer Aided Drug Design. It will also help us to acknowledge the application of CADD in modern drug discovery and development.

Report on Webinar Conducted on "Immunological Assay"

A state level webinar was conducted on the topic "Immunological Assay" at Oriental College of Pharmacy on 24/03/2021, where a total of 145 Mpharm Students (QA, Pharmaceutics and Pharmacology) students and Faculties from Mumbai, Pune, Nashik and Dubai attended the session live on Zoom video call.

The webinar started with greeting and welcoming all the participants by Host Mr. Krish Jain

Further a welcoming speech was given by Principal Madam and Convenor Dr. (Mrs.) Sudha Rathod, where madam introduced sir and updated the participants that sir is also the main CPCSEA nominee of Oriental College of Pharmacy IAEC committee.

A brief intro about the speaker Honb'le Dr. Dhanjit Das sir was read by the host.

(Dr Dhanjit K Das Brief Intro)

Dr Dhanjit K Das is working in the area of human genetics for last 10 years. Presently he is working as a Scientist at ICMR - National Institute for Research in Reproductive Health (NIRRH) located at Parel, Mumbai. His group has done extensive work in diagnosis of various genetic disorders by cytogenetic and molecular techniques. In the area of neurodevelopmental disorders, they evaluate the suspected cases of fragile X syndrome patients using a novel technique for presence of FMRP protein in their peripheral leucocytes and the diagnosis is confirmed by analysis of CGG repeat analysis in FMRP gene. Recently, his group is involved in identifying the genetic variation in cases of familial Schizophrenia using next generation sequencing. They have identified genetic variation in calcium channel genes as well as 22q11.2del in Schizophrenia. They are also engaged in development of induced Pluripotent Stem Cells (iPSCs) based cellular model for studying various neuro-psychiatric disorders specially schizophrenia. They have successfully developed neurons from iPSCs in order to develop cellular model for Schizophrenia. He has published more than 30 publications in reputed national and international journals. He has been awarded prestigious Indo-US fellowship for carrying out research in the area of Schizophrenia.

Then, the session started at 10:15am by the speaker. The session ended at 11:45am with a very informative and descriptive presentation slide by the speaker.


Following points were discussed with the laboratory staff:

THEME OF WORKSHOP

Pharmaceutical Quality by Design (QbD) is a systematic approach to development that begins with predefined objectives and emphasizes product and process understanding and process control, based on science and quality risk management.

The key challenge in pharmaceutical development is to design quality into drug product. This necessitates a profound understanding of product formulation and manufacturing processes. The knowledge gained from pharmaceutical development studies and manufacturing experiences provide scientific understanding to support establishment of design space. The design space is a multidimensional combination of input variables (e.g., material attributes) and process parameters that have been demonstrated to provide assurance of quality. Development of a design space involves full understanding of statistical relationship between input variables (e.g. raw material and active pharmaceutical ingredient attributes), manufacturing process parameters, and output response variables represented by finished drug product critical to quality attributes (CQA). Statistical methodologies, e.g. design of experiments (DOE), response surface, and statistical process control are principle tools to develop and implement the process design space.





