
Eco Club is the environmental club or green club of OCP with following functions:

Purpose: The essence of professional ethics is to ensure that professionals adhere to certain standards of behaviour, which are essential for building trust and maintaining the integrity of their profession.

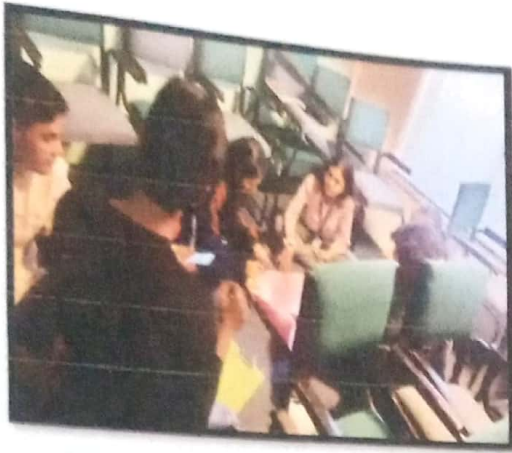
Resource person/s: Vasundhara Jakka (Learning facilitator)
