- The abstract should be submitted online via email in MS Word format, requirements: Times New Roman, font size-12, 1.5 line spacing with maximum 250 words.
- Only registered candidates will be allowed to present; the accepted papers and names must be one of the co-authors of the publication during submission.
- The number of authors should not exceed three.
- The abstract should include title in capital, author's surname followed by initials and affiliation.
- The name of the presenting author should be indicated by underlining the author's name.
- The size of the poster should not exceed 100 cm X 100 cm.
- Not more than one abstract should be submitted by one author.
- Three amongst the submitted abstracts will be selected for oral presentation and authors will be informed on or before 23/02/2019.
- A time slot of 15 minutes will be allotted to the presenter for presenting his/her work.

- Be able to suitably apply the principles of learning in varied learning contexts.

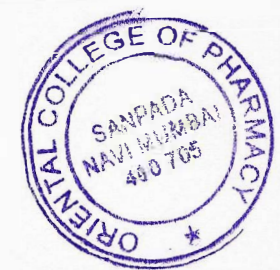

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
