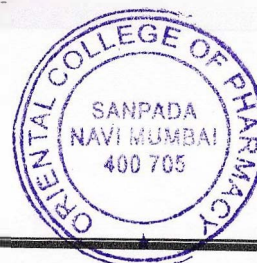

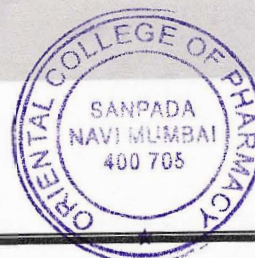



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REPORT

The Government of India under its 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' has initiated a program to create awareness about Intellectual Property Right amongst the students of various courses. It has developed the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) through which it aims to fulfill this goal. Under the current mission Oriental College of Pharmacy approached the Intellectual Property Rights Office in Mumbai and arranged a talk on the said subject.


The talk was organized by Mr. Abhijit Kanavaje, Associate Cultural In-charge and was held on 12th April 2022 between 12.30pm to 1.30pm in the Seminar Hall. At the outset our principal Dr. (Mrs.) Sudha Rathod gave a keynote address which was followed by the talk on 'Intellectual Property Rights'. The speaker, Dr (Ms.) Latika Dawtra, Assistant Controller of Patent & Design, IPO Mumbai delivered the talk. She spoke about the different types of Intellectual Properties, what is entitled for protection and what is excluded. She also spoke in depth about Patents and the different types of patent applications. Subsequently she explained the time lines for the different types of applications and the advantages of these individual applications. The talk was followed by a Question- Answer session during which the doubts asked by the audience were answered. The session definitely helped in enlightening the students and faculty in regards to Intellectual Property Rights.

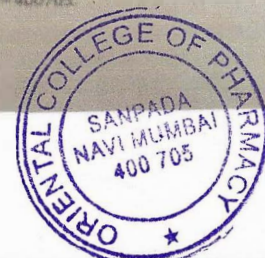

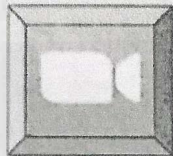

The Career Guidance and Entrepreneurship cell of Oriental College of Pharmacy, Navi Mumbai has organized webinar on "Government Job Opportunities after Pharm" on Zoom Cloud Live on 29th January, 2022 from 2.00 P.M to 3.30 P.M. The session was held for the pharmacy graduates and Dr. Anand Shedge was invited as the guest speaker for the day.

The creative team of the Entrepreneurship cell came up with official flyer and invite on January 27, which were circulated throughout the colleges of University of Mumbai and to other college across the country. More than 240 participants various pharmacy colleges had actively participated in the webinar.

The session started with the welcome of all the delegates by Principal and Convener, Dr. Sudha Rathod and Dr. Vandana Jain, (Coordinator, Career guidance and Entrepreneurship cell). Session was very informative and Mr. Vaibhav Jogi encouraged students by informative quotes as well. The session was indeed an enlightening one for all the students.


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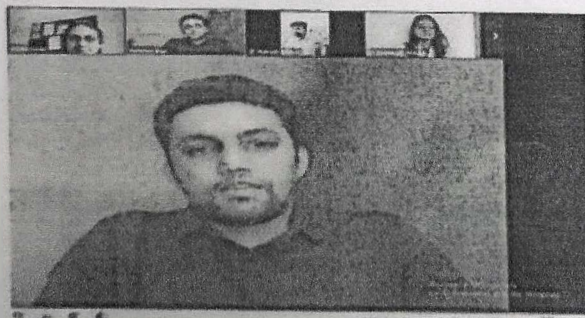

The session was indeed as an enlightening event for all the students. Mr. Girish kumar Trivedi has also encouraged the students by great informative probe .





Later, student's queries were been solved by the panellist. The session ended up with a motivational note by giving directions to the future aspirants.

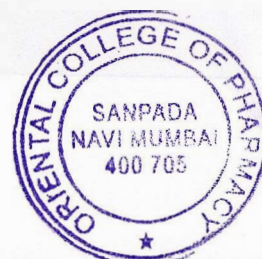
