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## WORKSHOP REPORT

Topic: Life Skills and Employability Program

The Placement Cell of Oriental College of Pharmacy had conducted "Barclays 3 day Life Skills and Employability Program" in collaboration with GTT foundation for Final Year B. Pharm students from 1st January to 2nd February, 2023 in the seminar hall.

On the first day, students learned about interview etiquettes. Fun activities were performed by forming teams for the better comprehension of the significance of interaction and healthy communication amongst team members.

On the second day, students learned about the various key elements necessary to be considered when drafting a resume. Copious points were discussed with respect to 'Do's and Don'ts' of Resume Writing. In the later session, students explored the execution of teamwork through two enjoyable and insightful activities. These activities helped the students understand how each team member's performance contributes to a successful result.

On day three, optimum ways of responding to challenging interview questions were discussed. A brief round of mock interviews and a practice public speaking exercise was conducted. The session was held for the Final Year B. Pharm students, First and Second Year. Pharm students in the seminar hall. Mrs. Anagha Bharkande was invited as the guest speaker for the day.

The concomitant Technical team of The Placement Cell came up with an official flyer and invite on 12th January, 2023. Students had avidly partaken in the seminar.

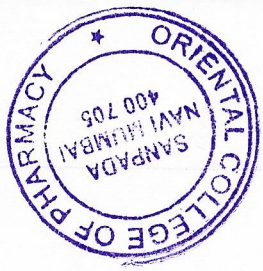

The hosts greeted the proficient speaker Mrs. Anagha Bharkande ma'am, Director of Statistical Programming at IQVIA, Mumbai. Further extending welcome to Honorable Principal - Dr. Mrs. Sudha Rathod ma'am, Placement Cell In charge - Dr. Mrs. Vandana Jain ma'am, Event coordinator - Dr. Mrs. Manasi Gholkar ma'am, Faculty Members and the assemblage. The hosts gave a brief introduction of the speaker - Mrs. Anagha Bharkande.

Mrs. Anagha Bharkande ma'am began her oration by introducing SAS, its overview for better understanding of the seminars' objective, its certification process, and the job opportunities. She then discussed its use in clinical trials. She swiftly touched upon the several stages of clinical trials and the data flow during clinical trials after that. She further elaborated on tools of the software used for data transformation, analysis, and transfer. She then spoke in detail on the advantages, applications, and limitations of SAS. She then discussed how people are switching to R because it provides results similar to those of SAS but doesn't require a license. She then described each component as she gave us a presentation of how SAS appears. She continued by outlining the two key steps: 1. Data step & 2. PROC step. She also gave an overview of the many SAS certifications available online and the hiring criteria that vary as per company. She enlisted several jobs in the Pharma Industry and how SAS evolves over a period of time. With an engaging Q&A session with the attendees, she concluded her presentation.

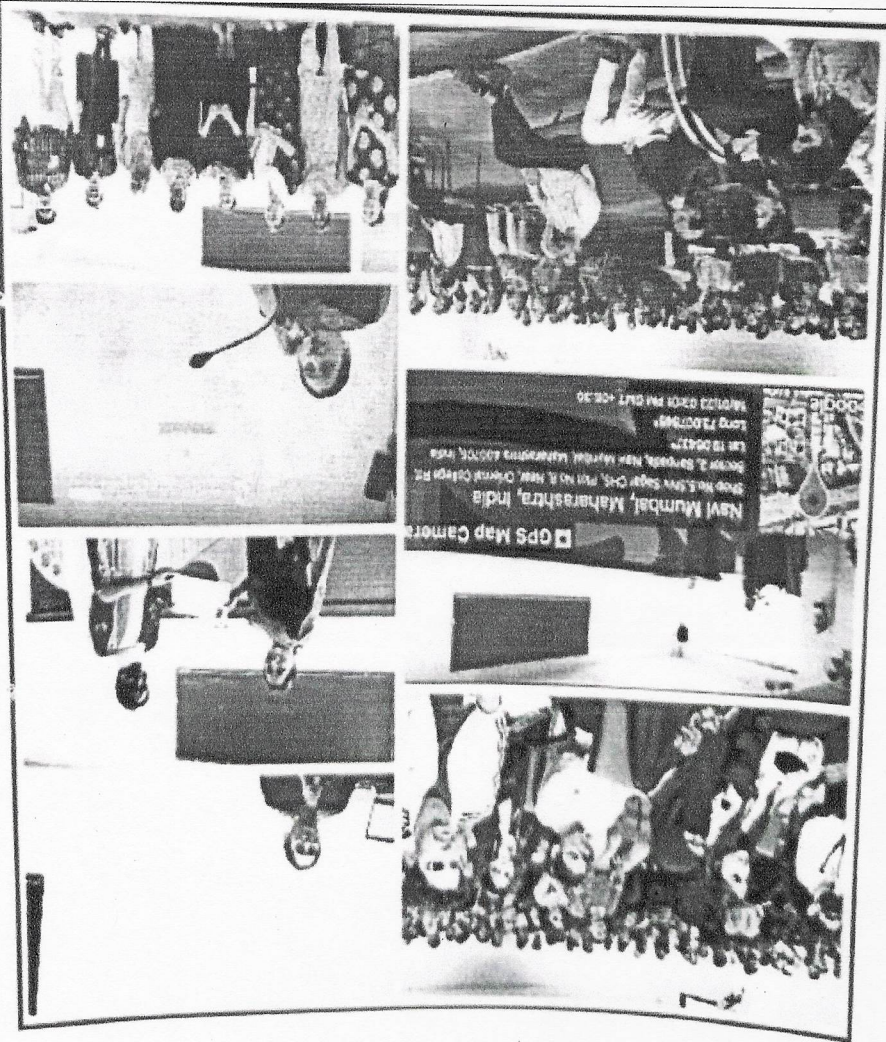

"Pedagogy is not about training, it is about critically educating people to be self-reflective, capable of critically addressing their relationship with others and with the larger world. Pedagogy in this sense provides not only important critical and intellectual competencies; it also enables people to intervene critically in the world." - Henry Giroux. Pedagogy, most commonly understood as the approach to teaching, is the theory and practice of learning, and how this process influences, and is influenced by, the social, political and psychological development of learners. First Dr. Vithoba Sawant briefed about explanation skill creative learning in which he talked about how Cooperative learning is an activity which helps students to work in groups and how it enables them to learn and teach group members. Also, the success of each member depends on the group's success. He then proceeded to further explain his topic with the help of a puppet show. He divided the teachers into groups of four and asked them to answer a few questions, with one of the group members to present the answer. Further he briefed about the importance of 2 way communication. Next, Prof. Pooja Tiwari provided us with some enlightening information about the role of stimulus variation skill technology in learning. She discussed how Google Classroom and other online platforms can be used to teach while keeping students' attention spans intact. She also talked about how the teacher should be aware of the students' conditions in class, as it is critical to make teaching and learning effective. The procedure is entertaining. The teacher should use stimulus variation that is appropriate for the students to get their attention. The teacher should be aware that providing the same stimulus at every meeting bores students. As a result, the teacher should incorporate some variety into the teaching and learning process. She goes on to explain that there are five components of the stimulus variation used by teachers, namely, changes in speech patterns, changes in interactions, and changes in sensory channels. Researchers directly observe classroom interactions to learn more about the components used by teachers in schools. Based on the results, it can be concluded that all components of the stimulus variation are used in the teaching and learning process. Prof. Kinkini Dutta largely focused on Education Innovation which is not a specific term

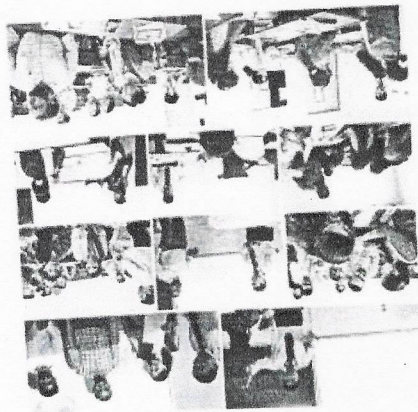

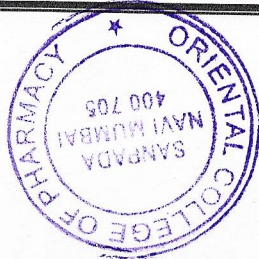

"The overall session was fruitful & interactive through out & worth our time" added a final year student. The session proceeded towards close, as sir welcomed questions from



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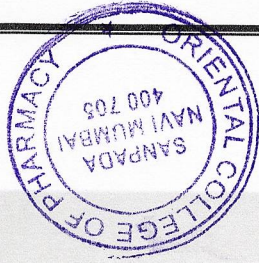

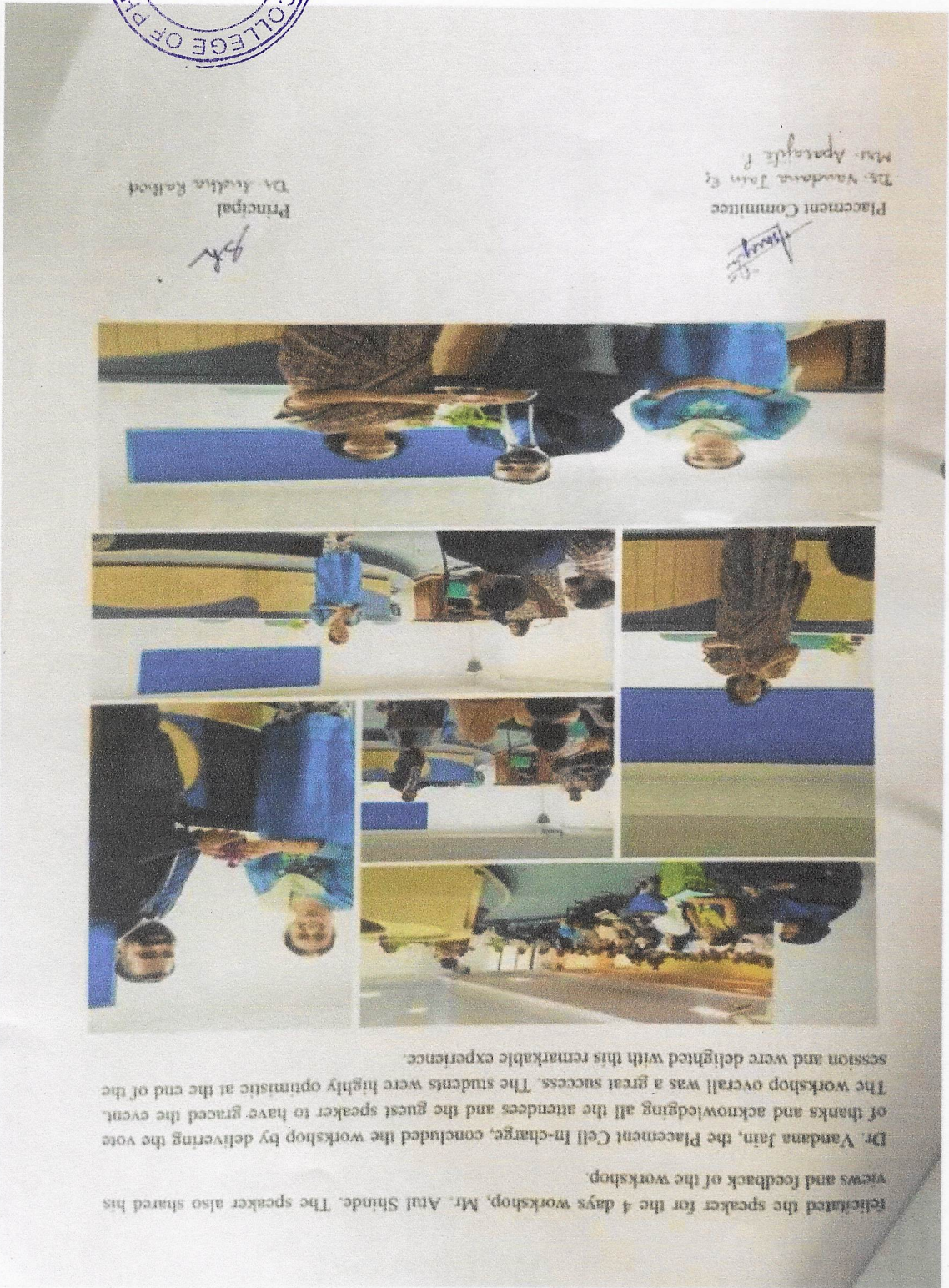
