

# **E-Poster Competition Rules**

- 1. e-posters will be categorized into Research-Based and Review-Based.
- 2. A maximum of 4 participants are allowed per e-poster.
- 3. Only the top 15 e-posters will be selected for the podium presentation and will be evaluated.
- 4.3 prizes will be awarded separately for each category (Research and Review).
- 5. The e-poster must be submitted in PDF format only.
- 6. Ensure that the content is original and plagiarism-free.
- 7. The e-poster should clearly present the research or review topic, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.
- 8. Each team will have 5 minutes to present their e-poster.
- 9. A 2-minute question-and-answer round will follow this.
- 10. The submission deadline is 27th August 2024 (Late submissions will not be considered under any circumstances)
- 11. E-posters will be evaluated based on clarity of content, scientific rigor, visual appeal, and originality.
- 12. Judges' decisions will be final and binding.
- 13. The e-poster should be designed to fit within a 1920x1080 pixel resolution.
- 14. Use high-resolution images and legible fonts (minimum size 12 pt) for all text.
- 15. Participants are required to refrain from revealing any identifying details on the e-poster, including the name of the college, participant names, guide names, or any other personal identifiers.
