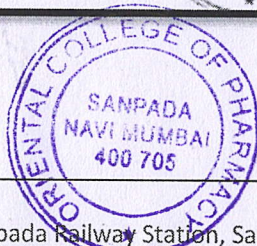
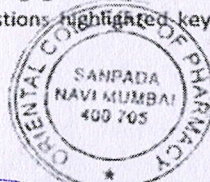
2. Session on IPR:

WHAT IS CLINICAL RESEARCH?

Clinical Research is a systematic study of new drugs to human subjects to generate data for discovering or verifying the Clinical Pharmacological including Pharmacokinetic and Pharmacodynamic or adverse effects with the objective of determining safety and efficacy of the new drug.

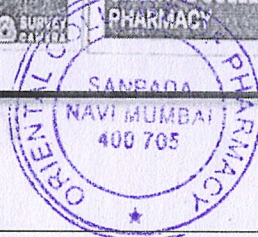
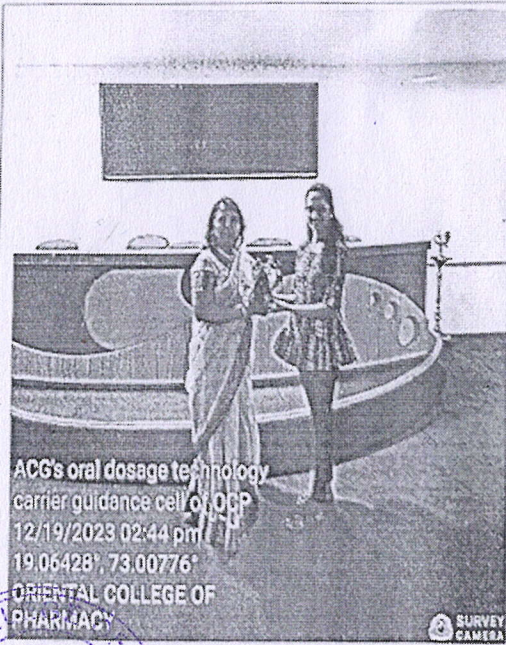
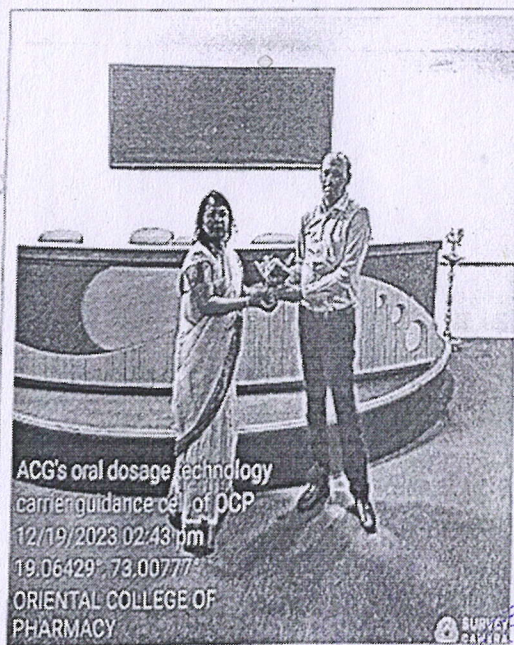
Industry-Institute Interaction and Career Guidance Cell A seminar report on Insights in ACG's Oral Dosage Technology

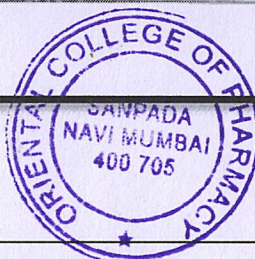
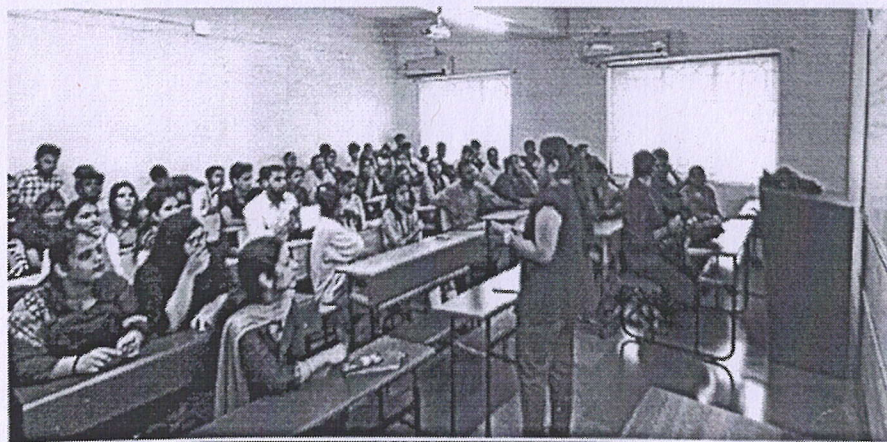
Career Guidance Cell Seminar Report on Counselling session to pursue higher studies abroad

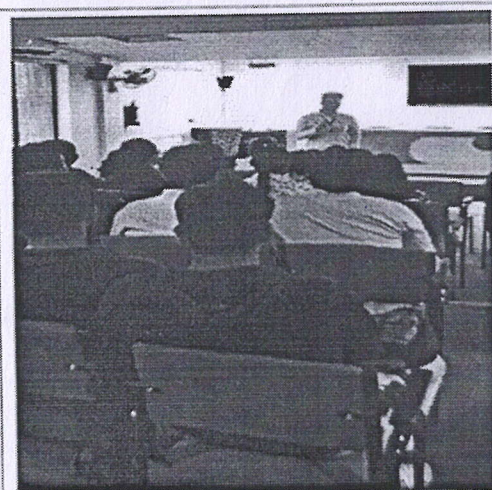
11th July 2023

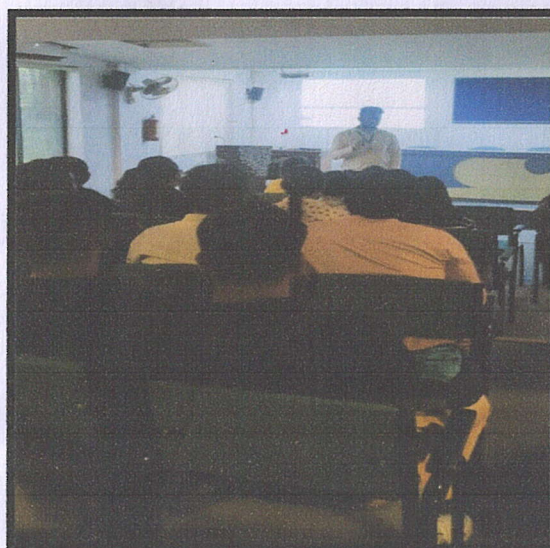

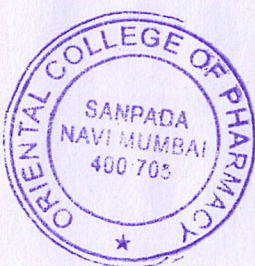
