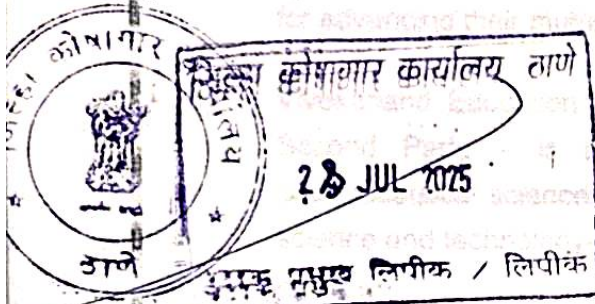




(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai – the Second Party – is an academic institution actively engaged in pharmaceutical sciences education and research, with collaborations in science and technology-driven biomedical fields.
- F) Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai – the Second Party – is a leading institution in the field of pharmaceutical education, supported by a vision to promote innovation and research in biomedical and healthcare sciences.
- G) Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai, is a reputed pharmacy institution committed to enhancing healthcare outcomes through quality education and research. The college strives to bridge the gap between academia and the bio-pharmaceutical industry by providing advanced R&D training to undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral students, as well as aspiring professionals. **NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTHIN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**CLAUSE 1  
CO-OPERATION**


- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

**CLAUSE 2  
SCOPE OF THE MoU**

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Both Parties agree to collaborate in enriching the curriculum by incorporating valuable insights from industry practices. The Second Party will provide inputs on teaching and training methodologies



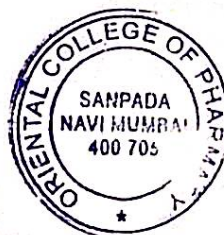





to help align academic instruction with evolving industry requirements, ensuring students are better prepared for professional roles.

- 2.3 Pilot Plant Training and Visit:** Both parties have mutually agreed to conduct pilot plant training and a site visit to facilitate effective knowledge transfer and ensure operational readiness. The training and visit will aim to familiarize the concerned personnel with the pilot plant's workflow, equipment, safety protocols, and standard procedures. During the visit, participants will receive a comprehensive overview of the plant's operations, including process flow, equipment handling, and quality control measures. The training will involve practical sessions on equipment operation, review of standard operating procedures (SOPs), troubleshooting practices, and safety measures. Emphasis will also be placed on data monitoring, process optimization, and preventive maintenance. Key technical staff from both parties will be involved to ensure effective communication and technical collaboration. The training aims to build competence in operating the pilot facility and understanding the nuances of the process before full-scale implementation. The visit and training schedule, including detailed agenda and participant list, will be finalized through mutual agreement, considering operational timelines and staff availability. Both parties will coordinate to provide necessary support, including documentation, equipment access, and on-site guidance, to ensure the program's success and to lay a solid foundation for future project stages.
- 2.4 Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of - - NAME OF INDUSTRY SPECIALIZATIONS, ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES - - API MANUFACTURING, PHARMACEUTICAL FORMULATIONS AND NDDS, Translational drug discovery and development, *in vitro* pharmacology, functional candidate screening and characterization.
- 2.5 Skill Development Programs:** Both Parties shall work together to conduct training programs focused on emerging technologies, aimed at bridging the existing skill gap and preparing students for industry roles more effectively.
- 2.6 Guest Lectures:** It is agreed that industry experts from the Second Party will be invited to deliver guest lectures to students of the First Party, focusing on current technological trends, industrial practices, and sector-specific expectations. *and vice versa.*
- 2.7 Faculty Development Programs:** Both Parties will collaborate on faculty development initiatives wherein the Second Party will offer training for faculty members of the First Party, enabling them to align their teaching approaches with industry requirements and applicable National Occupational Standards, where available.
- 2.8** Both Parties shall be responsible for securing the necessary internal approvals, permissions, consents, and licenses required for the

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successful implementation of programs and activities as per the terms of this Memorandum.

- 2.9 This Memorandum does not entail any financial obligation for either Party with respect to the execution of the outlined programs. Any financial considerations, if applicable, shall be addressed separately through mutual agreement and a distinct arrangement.

### CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement shall remain valid for a period of **Three (03) years** from the date of signing by both Parties, unless terminated earlier as per Clause
- 4.2. During this period, Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai (the Second Party), shall take effective steps for the implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of the Training Partner or Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai, after the expiry or termination of this Agreement—such as communication, correspondence, etc.—shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.3 Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving thirty (30) calendar days' prior written notice to the other Party. In the event of termination, both Parties shall be responsible for fulfilling any obligations undertaken prior to such termination.

### CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **Oriental College of Pharmacy and Vivekanand Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Mumbai**, are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of
