- Mr. Sabuwala is an external industry expert at OCP and a seasoned entrepreneur in the fragrance and cosmetic industry.


2. Mr. Khalid Qureshi – Entrepreneur, Healthcare Remedies Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai.

Participation:



Brief Summary of the session:



The Role of Healthcare Professionals: How proactive engagement in ADR reporting can lead to improved patient outcomes.














