

**Purpose:** To acquaint students with the various higher studies opportunities available abroad and to provide an overview of the process involved.

#### **Brief Summary of the session:**

The Career Guidance Cell of Oriental College of Pharmacy, Sanpada, organized a session for Third Year pharmacy students on the prospects of pursuing higher studies abroad on 20<sup>th</sup> July. 2024 from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm in class 403.

Ms. Sonali Jha discussed the benefits of studying abroad, including job opportunities, quality education, cultural diversity, and global exposure. She informed students about top universities and the annual living costs in countries such as the USA, UK, Canada, Germany, and Singapore. They provided detailed information about the application process, from selecting universities to securing admissions. 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




- Mr. Sabuwala is an external industry expert at OCP and a seasoned entrepreneur in the fragrance and cosmetic industry.


2. Mr. Khalid Qureshi – Entrepreneur, Healthcare Remedies Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai.



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



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

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







## **REPORT OF ETHICAL LAB ANIMAL HANDLING: PRACTICAL TRAINING WORKSHOP**

On 21<sup>st</sup> Feb. 2025 (Friday) one day workshop on “Ethical Lab Animal Handling: Practical Training Workshop” was successfully organized by Department of Pharmacology Oriental College of Pharmacy, Sanpada Navi Mumbai

The workshop started with the registration at 9.00 am with high tea. This one-day workshop saw enthusiastic participation from students and faculty members of our department and from other institutions like Kalsekar College of Pharmacy Panvel, Bharati Vidyapeeth College of Pharmacy Belapur, and Kokan Gnyapeeth Rahul Dharkar College of Pharmacy Karjat respectively. The diverse group of participants facilitated an exchange of ideas and experiences, enriching the learning environment. One of the key highlights of the workshop was the hands-on training session.

The welcome speech was given by Co-ordinator Dr. Sayyed Mateen who introduced about importance of the said workshop and mentioned the aim of the workshop is to provide comprehensive training on the ethical and safe handling of animals in research and laboratory level.

After lunch break session hands on training performed on experimental animals.

The second session started by Dr. Prabhakar Ukale. All the participants taken to Pharmacology research Labs to show the practical aspects and research activities. Under exposure schedule, participants visited Animal House Facility and other infrastructure.

- Routes of drug administration
- Blood withdrawal techniques

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


